WALDRON'S COVE, a small settlement in Twillingate district; population 60; all connections at or the same as Fortune Harbor, 3 miles.

WARD'S HARBOR, a post, fishing, lumbering and shipbuilding settlement in Twillingate district; nearest telegraph and port of entry Little Bay; all other connections at or the same as Little Bay Island; S. S. Lady Glover calls here; contains 3 stores, 2 churches; good harbor, safe entrance; population 285.

WARREN HARBOR, a small fishing settlement in Bonavista district; nearest post office Fair Island; all other connections at or the same as Green's Pond; population 70.

WEBBER'S BIGHT, a small fishing settlement in Twillingate district; all connections at or the same as Fortune Harbor, 1 mile, or Exploits, Burnt Island; population 35.

WELLMAN'S BIGHT or COVE (Sunday Cove Island), Notre Dame Bay, a small fishing settlement in Twillingate district; all connections at or the same as Little Bay Islands; population 40.

WESLEYVILLE, a post, telegraph, fishing and farming settlement in Bonavista district; nearest money order office and coastal boat Pool's Island, 3½ miles; telegraph Green's Pond, 7 miles; railway station Gambo, 30 miles; contains 8 stores, 2 churches; good harbor with safe entrance; population 500.

WESTERN ARM (Rocky Bay), a post fishing, farming, lumbering and shipbuilding settlement in District of Fogo; nearest money order office Musgrave Harbor, 18 miles; telegraph Gander Bay, 15 miles by land or Seldom-Come-Bye, by water; port of entry Fogo; coastal steamer Seldom-Come-Bye, connected by
