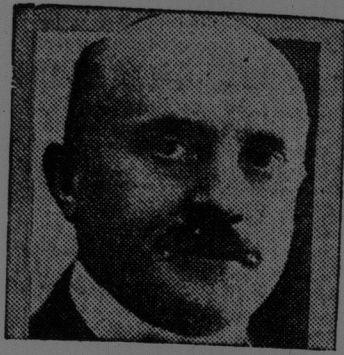


BRITISH LABOR  
MEMBER IS DEAD

(Canadian Press Despatch.)  
Teignmouth, Eng., Nov. 13.—Edmund Dene Morel, Labor member of the House of Commons, died here last night. He was a writer and journalist and his work in forming the Congo Reform Association in 1904 largely contributed to the exposure of the horrors in the Congo and resulted in their cessation. He was recommended this year for the Nobel peace prize. He was born in Paris in 1873.

DIES AS RESULT  
OF FORK WOUND

Yarmouth, Nov. 13.—Frances, wife of William O. Saulnier, of Meteghan, died at the hospital last evening following an accident with a fork. A few days previous she had the misfortune to injure one of her hands by piercing it with a fork, and blood poisoning developed. On advice of her physician Mrs. Saulnier was brought to Yarmouth for special treatment, but two days ago other complications created by the blood poison developed and caused her death. Mrs. Saulnier was 40 years of age and, besides her husband and several children, she leaves at Meteghan and vicinity a host of relatives and acquaintances.
