MONDAY, JUNE 26, 1826.

1st. Introductory Sermon by Elder JAMES MUNRO, from st Cor. 3d chap. 6th verse—" It is God who giveth the inrease." The sermon was peculiarly appropriate and intersting, and was followed by several warm addresses, after hich Elder J. DIMOCK read his Missionary Journal, and lder DAVIS made a statement of his Missionary labours ; when collection was taken for Missionary purposes, amounting to bout £13.

2d. The Ministers and Messengers composing the Associaon, took their seats. After prayer by Elder MANNING, lder JOSEPH DIMOCK was chosen Moderator; Elder WM. LDER, Clerk; and Elder J. MUNRO, Assistant Clerk. 3d. Read the Letters from the Churches.
