

6. Practical Classes bearing on the above for Honor Students of the Third Year will be held twice a week throughout the Session.

7. During the Easter Term a course of Systematic Botany with special reference to the Canadian Flora will be given.

Text Books: Huxley's Manual of Invertebrata, Sachs' Botany, Gray's Manual of Botany.

Various necessary works of reference are to be found in the Laboratory.

8. Honor Students of the Third and Fourth Years will attend a Series of Lectures on the Comparative Anatomy of the Vertebrata.

Text Books: Huxley's Vertebrata or Gegenbaur's Comparative Anatomy.

For Reference: Flower's Osteology of Mammalia, Parker and Bet-
tany's Morphology of the Skull.

9. The Practical Course for Fourth Year Students deals with the Osteology of Vertebrata and the Anatomy and Development of the Fowl.

Text Books: Martin and Moale's Vertebrate Dissection, Pt. II.;
Foster and Balfour's Hand Book of Embryology, 2nd ed.

For Reference: Wilder and Gage's Anatomical Technology.

Students taking Laboratory work will be provided with the necessary appliances and materials. A Laboratory Fee of \$1.50 will be charged to each student for the use of these.
