Decay of the Spruce.
To the Editor of the Montreal Witness.
Sir,—In your issue of May 17th, I read a communication from Fairman Hall on the subject of "The Decay of Spruce Timber." I am pleased to read in your valuable paper a few lines from an experienced person on such an important subject. I was not aware until I read Mr. Hall's letter that the spruce timber in Quebec was dying.

Decay of the Spruce.
The heat in the atmosphere of the Adirondack region in 1870-71 was about 3,400 feet below the surface—in far from being excessive. The temperature of the rock is but about 70 degrees Fahrenheit, while that of the atmosphere is a small fraction of a degree higher. In some parts of the Comstock lode in Nevada the temperature is 130 to 157 degrees at a depth of 1,800 to 2,000 feet.
