Herodotus, Thucydides, Euripides.

Tacitus: Germania, Agricola.
Juvenal and Persius.

In Third Year.

Sophocles, Æschylus, Longinus.
Aristophanes occasionally.
Tacitus and Juvenal, continued.
Lucretius occasionally.
