THE SINGLE ORIGINAL AGREEMENT IS NOT FOLLOWED OUT

Several Important Items Are Omitted From The Bill. BEFORE LEGISLATURE. The Agreement Between the City Council and the Hydro-Electric Company is Changed

The following is the agreement that was reached between the city council and the Hydro-Electric Co. on the 11th of November last, several details of which have been omitted from the bill now before the provincial legislature:

Resolved, that while the Mayor and the City Council of the City of St. John recognize the value to the city of cheaper power and feel that any proposals to procure the same should receive every encouragement, at the same time we are bound to protect the rights and safeguard our interests as a city and therefore memorialize the Governor and Council of the Province of New Brunswick, asking that the following changes be made in the proposed charter applied for under the name of the New Brunswick Electric Power:

1-Resolved, that the franchise, rights and powers granted by the city to the company be limited to a period of 50 years. 2-Resolved, that the admission of the company's extension to the streets, squares and plots of ground in the city of St. John be in the case of travelling on the city government, and further, that in case the city or any company should provide conduits, that the proposed company shall run their wires through the same and pay rent for the privilege.

Resolved, that if, in the removal of buildings or in the exercise of British maritime rights to a foreign country, falls to royal privateering, permits the sinking of untried neutrals, doubts the danger of starvation in case of war and, what is even worse, cripples in every way the action of the British fleet.

Resolved, that the rate for light and power described herein, immediately shall become the maximum rates of the purchasing company or companies. 9-That nothing in this agreement contained shall in any way prevent the rate herein set forth from being subject to revision at any time by the public utilities commission.

Resolved, that the city of St. John be given the right of buying out the said company's franchise and property at a reasonable price, such price to be arrived at by the utilities commission in the event of the city and the company failing to agree on a price.
