

ROBERTSON, *Lieut. Col. Hon. John, J. P.*

Is a mem. of the Senate of the University of New Brunswick. Consul at St. John for the Argentine Republic: Lieut. Col. 1st. Batt. St. John City Light Infantry Militia; a director of the Bank of British North America. and of the Victoria Coal Mining Co., and a mem. of the Council of the Chamber of Commerce, St. John. Was a mem. of the Leg. Council, N. B., before the Union. Called to the Senate, May, 1867.—*St. John, N. B.*

ROSS, *Lieut. Col. Hon. John, Q. C. L.*

B. in Co. Antrim, Irel., 10th March, 1818. Ed. at the Johnstown (Ont) District School. M. Miss Baldwin, dau. of the late Hon. Robert Baldwin, C. B. Called to the Bar, U. C., Michaelmas Term, 1839. Created Q. C., 1850. Is Lieut. Col. 2nd Batt. Toronto Militia, and a mem. of the Senate of Albert College, Belleville. Was President of the Grand Trunk Railway Company for many years; and a Govt. director of the same railway from Nov., 1852 until July, 1857. Was Solicitor General, U. C., from Nov. 1851 to June, 1853, when he was appointed Attorney General for U. C., which office he held until September, 1854. Was Speaker of the Leg. Council, Can., from the latter date until 1856; Receiver General from 2 Feby. to 29 July, 1858; and President of the Executive Council and Minister of Agriculture from 7 August, same year, to 27 March, 1862, when he resigned.
