forbid) between the said Crowns in *Europe*, no Act of Hostility, neither at Land nor at Sea, shall however be done by any of the most Serene King of *Great Britain's* Garrisons, Souldiers or Subjects whomsoever of the Islands, Colonies, Forts, Cities and Governments, which now are, or hereafter shall be under the *English* Dominion in *America*, against the most Serene most Christian King's Subjects, inhabiting or residing in any of the *American* Colonies: Likewise reciprocally, that in the abovesaid case of a Breach in *Europe*, no Act of Hostility, neither at Land nor at Sea, shall however be done by any of the most Serene most Christian King's Garrisons, Souldiers or Subjects whomsoever of the Islands, Colonies, Forts, Cities and Governments, which now are, or hereafter shall be under the *French* Dominion in *America*, against the most Serene King of *Great Britain's* Subjects inhabiting in any of the *American* Colonies, or residing there. But a true and firm Peace and Neutrality shall continue in *America* between the said *British* and *French* Nations in the same manner, as if such Breach in *Europe* had not happened.
