
Ottawa 29th October, 1901.

Sir,

I beg to inform you that the Palmerston Pork Packing Company has advised the Department of the shipment for you of forty sacks ~~sixty~~ containing 6500 pounds of bacon. They state also that they have shipped to Prince Albert Station nine sacks containing 1500 pounds. This bacon completes the July delivery, and owing to the fact of the late delivery and also of the quantity purchased during the past season it is assumed that the whole of the November delivery will not be required. The Department has written the contractors instructing them not to make shipment on account of the November delivery until they are further advised. It will therefore be necessary for you to inform the Department at once what quantity of bacon you will require.

The invoices of the bacon which has been shipped you ~~are~~ enclosed herewith.
