I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your communication of the 23rd instant, inclosing a declaration by Mr. Allan McPherson in connection with his application for renewal of license covering a portion of the Whitefish Lake Indian Reserve, and in reply to say that, in view of the circumstances as set out in the declaration, the Department is disposed to grant a further renewal of this license for one year, namely, to the 30th of April, 1908, upon compliance with all the conditions of the license with regard to payment of ground rent, renewal fee, dues, etc.

It is to be distinctly understood that this is the last renewal that will be granted of this license and the same is to finally cease and determine at the expiration of said renewal.
