



Sir,

I beg to inform you that recently the Department authorized expenditure to the amount of \$60.00 for repairs to a barn owned by Mrs Catherine Herkimer on lot 6 Con 1 Oneida. \$59.80 has actually been expended and Mrs Herkimer complains that the barn is not completed, and she states that the matter has been neglected by the Agent, Mr Van Loon. She also complains that undesirable tenants are occupying her house on the same property. The Department desires that you will look into both matters while you are at the New Credit Reserve, and that you will make full reports thereon to the Department.
