I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 28th ultimo, and with reference to the grievance set forth therein I beg to say that when the cattle belonging to Indians wander off the reserve into an adjoining municipality they are liable to be dealt with according to the by-laws of the municipality The Department cannot interfere with such by-laws.
