Sir,

I have the honor to acknowledge your letter of the 16th ultimo No 208361 regarding the March Pay List and in answer would state that

Band No 29 is a very aged <sup>person</sup> who has been an invalid for a number of years, her share was paid to her nephew Matt George with whom she resides

Band No 32 was suffering from neuralgia so badly on Pay-day it was impossible for her to be present her share was also paid to Matt George her Uncle with whom she then resided.

Band No 42 is dead. his Mother Band No 124 is totall blind having no husband & being to some extent dependant on him her only son. The Chief & Council advised me to pay it over to her

Band No 59 was sick & could not attend on Pay-day her share was paid on consent of the Chief & Council to her son No 60

Band No 78 is an old man an invalid, quite deaf & unable to understand me. his share was sent on the advice of the Chief & Council to him with a Councilman in whom I have confidence.

I have noted the instruction given in the last paragraph of above letter & will hereafter be guided thereby
