Mr. Kearney seemed to have no strong views on the use of the words "Eire" and "Ireland". He said that in Dublin there was a tendency to approve of the use abroad of the word "Eire" because it was an Irish word. However, official opinion preferred the use of "Ireland" in English because of the implied claim to the whole island.

5. INFORMATION

Mr. Kearney thought that the Dublin office was receiving sufficient information about Canada. They would like however to see more of the despatches from Moscow and other missions. At present their view was somewhat narrow as to Canadian policy ~~to~~ world events.
