Further to my letter of March 27th, 1951, attached hereto is Toquaht Band resolution dated July 19th, 1951, authorizing the Tidewater Contracting Company Limited to continue their logging operations on the above-mentioned Reserve.

We were able, through negotiation, to secure from the Tidewater Contracting Company, additional stumpage of \$2.00 per thousand for all timber removed or to be removed from the Reserve. (Copies of Superintendent Garrard's letter of August 28th and Company's letter of August 24th are attached).

Superintendent Garrard has been advised that the additional stumpage is to be paid to the Band Trust Account in the usual manner.
