



C.P.R. STEAMER "SICAMOUS" ARRIVING FROM THE SOUTH

HOW TO REACH KELOWNA



FROM Sicamous on the main line of the Canadian Pacific Railway, where is located one of the chain of the Company's hotels, transfer is made to a branch line running to Okanagan Landing, a distance of 46 miles, where connection is made by steamer with Kelowna and other lake points; or, if desirable, one can leave the train at either Enderby, Armstrong or Vernon, and motor over excellent roads, viewing scenery rivalling that of Switzerland. In this way, also, a more comprehensive idea of the valley is obtained than from the steamers. Kelowna is also reached by the southern system of the C.P.R. at Penticton, thence by steamer or lake shore drive, a distance of 40 miles.
