

falgar, distant from Toronto twenty-five miles ; from Hamilton fourteen and from Milton twelve miles. It contains three churches, the Baptist and two Methodist Episcopal churches, (one being for a colored congregation) one Hotel, three stores, a blacksmith shop and a School House. The harbor is good and rendered safe by Rivers' Cape, which protects it from east and north-east winds ; a considerable amount of shipping is carried on at this place. The town was surveyed and laid out by Government in 1834, when it received the name it still bears.
