#### Synopsis of Canadian North-West.

#### HOMESTEAD REGULATIONS

A NY even numbered section of A Dominion Lands in Manitoba, Saskatchewan and Alberta, excepting 8 and 26, not reserved, may be homesteaded by any person who is the sole head of a family, or any male over 18 years of age, to the extent of one-quarter section of 190 acres, more or less.

Entry must be made personally at the local land office for the district in which the landle situate. Entry by proxy may, however, be made on certain conditions by the father, mother, som, daughter, brother or sister of an intending homesteader.

The homesteader is required to perform the homestead conditions under one of the following plans:

(1) At least six months' residence upon and cultivation of the land in each year for three years.

and in each year for three years.

(2)—If the father is deceased) of the homesteader residue upon a farm in the vicinity of the land entered for, the requirements as to residence may be satisfied by such person residing with the father or mother.

(8) If the settler has his permanent residence upon farming land owned by him in the vicinity of his homestead, the requirements as to residence may be satisfied by residence upon the said land.

Six months' notice in writing should be given to the Commis-sloner of Dominion Lands at Ot-tawa of intention to apply for patent.
