- The Sum of Four Hundred and Fifty Pounds towards the Relief of the Relief of the Poor Poor in Bonavista Bay, Trinity Bay, Conception Bay, and the District Bay, &c. of Fogo, appropriated by His Excellency the Governor upon Address from the House of Assembly of the date April Tenth, Eighteen Hundred and Forty-nine.
- The Sum of Fifty Pounds appropriated by Eighth Victoria, Cap. Fifteen, Reappropriation towards the Erection of a Wharf at Keels, and remaining in the Treasury wharf at Keels. undrawn, to be appropriated in the Making and Repairing of Streets in the same place, under the direction of His Excellency the Governor.
- The Sum of Forty Pounds to the Saint John's Water Company, to de-Fire Plage, st. John's Water fray Expense of keeping Fire Plugs in repair.
- Company. The Sum of One Hundred Pounds towards defraying Expense of pro-Portable Mills. curing Portable Mills.

The Sum of Five Hundred Pounds to defray Unforeseen Contingencies, Contingencies.

II.-And be it further enacted, That the Monies hereinbefore granted Monies herein shall be paid by the Colonial Treasurer in discharge of such Warrants as paid. may from time to time be drawn by the Governor or Administrator of the Government for the time being, for the purposes of this Act, and that it shall not be lawful for the Colonial Treasurer to pay any Monies out of the Colonial Treasury, other than such as are granted in this Act or some other Act of the Legislature.
