II.—*And be it further enacted*, That the Monies hereinbefore granted shall be paid by the Colonial Treasurer in discharge of such Warrants as may from time to time be drawn by the Governor or Administrator of the Government for the time being, for the purposes of this Act, and that it shall not be lawful for the Colonial Treasurer to pay any Monies out of the Colonial Treasury, other than such as are granted in this Act or some other Act of the Legislature.
