### Searching For Evidence Against Dr. Wilkins

The Elderly Long Beach N. Y. Physician Charged With Murdering His Wife

Long Beach, N. Y., March 18.—While search was in progress today for Dr. Walter Keene Wilkins, elderly physician, charged with murdering his wife at their home on February 27th, the authorities here and in New York City were obtaining what they hoped would be consistent evidence. Important enough to present to a jury.

It was announced that at Dr. Wilkins' home in New York they had found a piece of lead pipe similar to that picked up beside Mrs. Wilkins' body after he told the police that he had killed her. Inside this pipe the investigators found a piece of a long, sharp, needle-pointed dagger. There was a piece of the same dagger, wrapped around a hammer head near Mrs. Wilkins' body.

### Sawmill Burned At Avery's Portage

Had Only Been Built Last Spring—Owner Refused to Sell About Week Ago

Word has reached here that a fire has completely destroyed the sawmill owned by Mr. B. J. Thibault, of Pointe-aux-Lacs, at Avery's Portage, on the Rich River, and also a dwelling house owned by J. Woodcock.

The fire, which was of purely accidental origin, started in a house owned by Mr. J. Woodcock and with a still wind blowing at the time it was not long before the mill was on fire, and soon burned to the ground.

The loss is a heavy one as the mill was only completed last spring. It had a cut of 25000 to put through but on account of the severity of the fire was only able to cut about 10000. Mr. Thibault refused an offer for the sale of the mill about a week before it was destroyed by fire, but had turned it over to him. He will start to rebuild as soon as he can.

### Boy Fscared By A Leap From Train

Saw Detective Approach and Jumped; Train Stopped but Search Fruitless

Montreal, March 19.—A daring escape was made by a sixteen-year-old boy wanted for theft in Ottawa, when he jumped from a speeding train into the snow after the train had left the Mile End Station. The boy's description had been sent to the Montreal detective office with a request to arrest him on the train from Ottawa, and hold him until a detective from Ottawa came to get him. A detective was sent to the Mile End Station to meet the train. After making sure that no boy answering the description left the train there, the detective boarded the train, which then started for Place Viger Station, and asked the conductor if he had seen the boy. The conductor was not sure and went through the train to ascertain. He returned and reported to the detective that there was a boy who might be the one wanted, though he did not tally with the description. While the detective made his way to the car the boy got up, ran to the front of the coach and standing on the last step, took a leap into the snow before the detective could reach him. The emergency signal to stop the train was immediately given and the train came to a standstill within a few hundred feet. A search was made for the boy, but no trace of him was found, and the train proceeded on its way. Inspector Cowan was at once notified, and he went in person with other detectives to search the spot, in case the boy might be injured and freeze to death. There was no trace of the boy, however, and the detectives had to give up the search.


