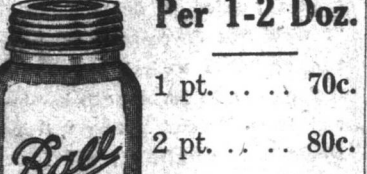

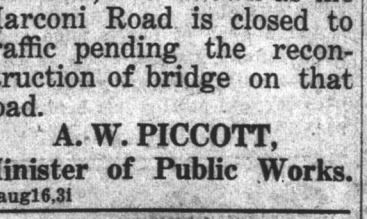
The Kilbride Derby Sweep Draw.
