There has been a good season for the lavender grower, and if he is now up with the work, and by no means late, he can recall has ever been able to catch these wondrous shifting tints with anything like truth.

Spring frosts often do considerable damage to the lavender plants, but although this year the frosts were keen enough to cut down the potato haulm they seemed to have spared the lavender.

Lavender growing is certainly one of the things better done in England than in France, for a pound of English oil of lavender is worth more than a pound of the French lavender is worth.

The harvesting which is now proceeding has to be conducted with great care. The fields are rapidly ripening under the summer sun, and all the reaping which is done for the cutters of "sweet lavender" is done in the month of August.
