British and United States Governments Are Desirous of a Settlement.

Washington, Dec. 29.—It is expected that the efforts will be renewed before long for the settlement of numerous controversies which have long existed between the United States and Great Britain, growing out of relations along the Canadian border, the Atlantic fisheries, warships on the Great Lakes, the Alaskan boundary and other questions. The negotiations designed to secure a settlement of the matters referred to have not proved effective, largely because of the cumbersome machinery of negotiation, and this has led to a belief that much more could be accomplished by direct negotiations between Secretary Hay and Lord Pauncefote, on the main points, and the subsequent assembling of a commission representing the United States and Great Britain, Canada, to give form to the basis of the agreement reached. The British negotiators have insisted that when the Alaskan boundary and other pending questions, the canal treaty being regarded as one of many pending issues.

Now that the British government has yielded the Clayton-Bulwer treaty and other points in the Alaskan negotiations, it desires to take up some of the other questions in which they have important interests involved.

PAINFUL ACCIDENT.

Former Victorian Has His Hands Badly Burned.

Manager C. G. Ballentyne, of the Honolulu Rapid Transit Company, met with an experience with the cable but powerful electric fluid yesterday which does not care in the least to have re- spected. Mr. Ballentyne, however, is a good and efficient reasoner, and con- sidered himself upon his narrow escape from serious accident, after his encoun- ter with a hot motor through which was passing a high voltage of electricity.

As it was Mr. Ballentyne, who had been badly burned about the hands and wrists, and the electric fluid was not con- sidered by him as a serious matter, he was not at all surprised when he was in- sulted.

Manager Ballentyne was a passenger on a Rapid Transit car which was pro- ceeding along Leavenworth street yester- day morning. The car was stopped, and the motorist and conductor, under the di- rection of the manager, proceeded to examine into the trouble. The car stop- ping was removed, the current shut off and the wires were inspected.

The difficulty being apparently re- moved, the power and electric current were ordered turned on. Mr. Ballen- tyne had, however, neglected to with- draw his hands in time to avert re- sulting injury. He received a severe shock and for a moment appeared much dis- tressed. Mr. Ballentyne, however, quickly recovered, and with the exception of several blisters about the hands he succeeded in escaping more serious consequences.

Death at Hospital.—Algeron Judson Palmer, of Kamloops, died at the Jubilee hospital yesterday morning. He was a native of Wentworth County, Ontario, aged 48 years. He leaves a widow to mourn his loss. The remains were sent to Kamloops by this morning's train.
