Corn $\frac{1}{4}$ lower, weak, holders willing to sell, buyers holding off. Closing March 5—10 $\frac{1}{2}$, May 5—10, July 5—10 $\frac{1}{2}$.

Chicago wheat opened $\frac{1}{8}$ lower on lower cables dull, no business to speak of. Think wheat will go some lower before, it will do to buy again.

Corn opened same as last night's closing and sold $\frac{1}{4}$ quarter higher to drop again at the opening prices.

Oats steady at an advance of 1-16.

Provisions opened slightly higher and dull, not much doing this morning.
