## INTERNAL REGULATIONS OF THE INTER-AMERICAN CONFERENCES ANNEXED TO THE INTER-AMERICAN TELECOMMUNICATIONS CONVENTION

#### Décembre 1937, et ses annexes American governments, delegates, and representatives

When in the Inter-American Convention concerning Telecommunication of which these internal Regulations form a part, the words "American Gover" ments", "Delegates" and "Representatives" are mentioned, they shall understood to mean:

a) "American Governments": The governments of the State Colonies and Territories of the American Region.

b) "Delegates": The persons officially appointed by the participa" ing Governments with sufficient powers to act on their behalf.

c) "Representatives": Members of public or private institution or bodies or private individuals associated with telecommunications persons representing enterprises or groups of enterprises and bodies who are accredited by their who are accredited by their respective governments to observe the proceedings of the conferences; who in plenary sessions shall have neithe voice nor vote, and who there may express their points of view on through the delegation of their respective country.

### ARTICLE 2

## Officers of the conference

§ 1.° Provisional President: The organizing Government shall appoint the Provisional President who shall preside over the inaugural session and cort tinue in office until the Conference has elected its Permanent President.

§ 2.° Permanent President: The Permanent President shall be elected by a majority vote of the voting Delegations present at the Conference.

§ 3.° Vice-Presidents: At the first meeting, there shall be appointed three Vice-Presidents to substitute for the President where necessary. The order precedence of the Vice-Presidents shall be determined by lot.

§ 4.° Secretary General: The Secretary General of the Conference shall be appointed by the organizing Government.

#### ARTICLE 3

## Duties of the officers

§ 1.° President: The President shall direct the work of the Conference announce the opening, suspension and adjournment of the meetings of the Conference, accord the right to speck in the Conference, accord the right to speak in the order requested, declare the debates to be closed, put the questions to vote, announce the result of the voting, ensure the observance of the Regulations and perform such other duties as may properly devolve upon his office.
