DEAR MR. MARTIN:

I wish to acknowledge receipt of your letter of September 20, 1965 proposing that the amount made available under Section 2(a) of the Agreement of December 4, 1964 between the Government of Canada and the Inter-American Development Bank be increased from the specified initial sum of CDN\$10 million to a total of CDN\$20 million, which additional funds will be available on the same terms and conditions as those relating to the original Canadian contribution.

I am pleased to inform you that the Board of Executive Directors of the Bank has authorized me on behalf of the Bank to accept your proposal and has requested me to express the great appreciation of the Bank for this further contribution by the Government of Canada to the development of Latin America.

We further agree that your letter and this reply shall constitute an amendment to the Agreement of December 4, 1964, effective the date hereof.
