59. The two Parties expressed their interest in exchanging teachers and technical personnel having expertise in various aspects of film-making.

The details will be determined through diplomatic channels.

60. The two Parties will invite each other to take part in each other's international film festivals, and for this purpose will extend the corresponding invitations through diplomatic channels.

61. The two Parties will exchange films, and for this purpose, as an initial step, they will provide each other with the corresponding catalogues.

62. The RTC and the Instituto Mexicano de Cinematografía expressed the wish to receive copies of Mexican films now held in Canada, as well as of classic Canadian films, whether through donation, exchange, or sale, as a contribution by the Government of Canada towards the rebuilding of the collection of the Cineteca Nacional de México [National Film Library of Mexico], which was reopened on 27th January 1984.

The Canadian side took note of this and will convey this request to the Public Archives of Canada. Subsequently, it will provide Mexico with a list of the films in question.

63. Each country will hold film festivals focussing on the films of the other country, with relevant accompanying exhibits.
