

Monkfish:

The demand for this species has continued to increase and the domestic catches are no longer sufficient to meet the country's requirements. The market is for tails which arrive IQF, packed in polyethylene-lined 10 kg cartons. The product is generally used at the retail level and in restaurants. Current wholesale price is Esc 900-1000 per kg.

Sole/Flounder:

Virtually all species of sole and flounder should find a market in Portugal, provided the price is acceptable to the Portuguese buyers. The product form preferred for these species is frozen, with the head-off and gutted.

Turbot/Greenland & Atlantic Halibut:

There is some potential for these two members of the flatfish family, particularly the former. The preferred product form is frozen, with the head-off and gutted. These species are used primarily in the retail sector and in restaurants.
