accomplished on such issues as OAS reform, democratic development, human rights, the environment and drugs; and our goals for the future as committed partners of the OAS and the hemisphere.

In summary,

- * Canada has made solid progress towards its objectives in the first year of OAS membership;
- We have been an active, autonomous and effective member of the OAS, as recommended by the Standing Committee on External Affairs and International Trade in its February 1990 report;
- * Canada can make a difference, acting together with our partners in the OAS, on hemispheric issues which are important to Canadians.
