

6. During the period of this programme both sides agree to support an exchange of up to three writers or poets for a maximum period of three weeks on the basis of itineraries to be negotiated upon in advance directly and separately between the Writers' Union of Canada, l'Union nationale des Ecrivains québécois and the Union of Soviet Writers. The purpose of this exchange will be to allow writers to participate in seminars on themes previously agreed upon in advance between the participating writers' organizations. International air travel up to the point of reception will be the responsibility of the sending country; the receiving country will pay internal transportation from this point to the last location of the agreed programme and living expenses;

7. To encourage exchanges of information about historical sites and ancient monuments, their methods of popularization, their conservation and restoration and also to explore the possibility of exchanging specialists in these fields;

8. To consider proposals for the distribution, on the basis of reciprocity, of information materials published or issued in each country by the Embassies of Canada and of the USSR;

9. To encourage and facilitate exchanges and visits, not otherwise provided for, of writers, theatre stage directors, architects, specialists in different branches of the law, and other persons engaged in cultural and professional activities, for familiarization with areas of interest and for participation in meetings and symposia. Terms will be worked out in advance by the organizations concerned on a mutually acceptable basis;
