

- (ii) one additional air traffic controller in position in the Dakar Flight Information Centre;
- (iii) installation and maintenance of the equipment provided for the additional air traffic controller position;
- (iv) two technical personnel to assist in the extension of the operations of the Regional Meteorological Centre, Dakar, to meet the requirements of the Experiment;
- (v) two offices, each about 16 square metres in area, in the new terminal building at Dakar Airport, for use by GATE aircraft ground co-ordinators.

Article 6—Specific Undertakings on the Part of the Organization

The Organization shall arrange that the other participating Member States, either jointly or individually (as may be agreed between them) and for the duration of the Experiment:

- (a) shall provide a maximum of 8 forecasters to assist in the extension of the operations of the Regional Meteorological Centre, Dakar, to meet the requirements of the Experiment and therefore consider the acceptance of 3 or 4 Senegalese engineers in a large research centre such as Miami or Bracknell for a training period of 3 to 4 months;
- (b) shall provide facilities for the participation of available Senegalese forecasting and research personnel in the operations referred to in paragraph (a) of this Article;
- (c) shall arrange for the Project Manager to designate a Port Liaison Officer to collaborate with the Dakar Port Authorities in providing support for the Experiment;
- (d) shall provide the additional transmitting equipment (transmitters, dipole antennae) and receivers required for the additional air traffic control position referred to in sub-paragraph (f) (iii) of Article 5 above, together with the necessary spare parts;
- (e) shall provide and install the equipment and furnish the operators and maintenance staff required for the Communications Centre of the GOCC;
- (f) except as otherwise provided above or as may be otherwise agreed by the parties concerned at some future date, shall provide, or arrange for the provision of, all ships and aircraft, all technical equipment and supplies and all personnel required for the conduct of the Experiment.

Article 7—Term

This Protocol of Execution shall enter into force upon signature of both parties and shall be coterminous with the Agreement on the GARP Atlantic Tropical Experiment (GATE) between the World Meteorological Organization, the Government of the Republic of Senegal and other Member States participating in the Experiment.
