3. The request to visit shall contain the following information:

- (a) name of the visitor, date and place of birth, nationality, and passport number;
- (b) official title of the visitor and the name of the entity represented by him or her;
- (c) a certification of the level to which the visitor has been security screened by the appropriate security authority of the visiting Party;
- (d) planned time and date of the visit;
- (e) name of the military organizations or defence facilities to be visited;
- (f) name of persons in the host country to be visited; and
- (g) the purpose of the visit.

4. A Party may request a visit approval, including an approval for intermittent recurring visits to a specified defence establishment or facility, for a period not exceeding twelve (12) months. When it is expected that a particular visit may not be completed within the approved period or that an extension of the period for intermittent recurring visits is required, the visiting Party shall submit a new request for visit approval not less than twenty (20) working days prior to the expiration of the current visit approval.

5. In special cases, one Party may decline to give permission to a visit by personnel of the other Party or may give permission to visit the military organization or defence facilities but refuse access to classified military information.

6. All visitors shall comply with the security regulations of the host Party and relevant instructions of the establishment to be visited.

ARTICLE 12

Visits by Security Personnel

1. Each Party shall permit authorized security personnel of the other Party to visit defence establishments, facilities and controlled areas where classified military information is stored, when mutually convenient and in accordance with the procedures set out in Article 11:

- (a) to obtain access to classified military information; and
- (b) to discuss with the National Security Authority of the other Party its procedures and practices applied for the protection of classified military information.

2. Each Party shall assist the authorized security personnel of the other Party in the exercise of their functions under paragraph 1 of this Article.
