Geneva in the spring of 1975. It was expected that discussion would continue at this session on Protocol I, more particularly on the desirability of extending in some way the application of the Geneva Conventions to include wars of selfdetermination and national liberation movements. The Canadian delegation was expected to continue to seek the adoption of a second protocol extending to victims of non-international armed conflict the fundamental humanitarian provisions now reflected in Article 3 common to all four Geneva Conventions, through the establishment of new basic provisions of the kind that any responsible government should wish to apply in the exercise of its sovereignty.
