His Excellency General Angel Ernesto Peluffo today presented to the Governor-General his Letter of Credence as Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary of Argentina to Canada. The ceremony took place at Government House at 11:30 a.m. The Chief of Protocol, Mr. H.F. Feaver presented the Ambassador to His Excellency the Governor-General. Mr. Henry F. Davis, Acting Assistant Under-Secretary of State for External Affairs and Mr. Esmond Butler, Secretary to the Governor-General were in attendance on the Governor-General on this occasion.
