Question No. 518, by Mr. Macdonald (Rosedale),—Order of the House for a Return showing: 1. Is there an organization known as Maple Leaf Services operating canteens at certain locations of the Canadian Army and providing refreshments to ranks below the rank of sergeant and, if not, is there any organization operated for that purpose, and what is its name?

If the answer to the above is in the affirmative (a) what is the legal nature of the organization (i) body corporate (ii) partnership or (iii) sole proprietorship (b) if the organization is incorporated (i) under the laws of what jurisdiction was it incorporated (ii) is it incorporated with the object of profit or gain to its shareholders or members (iii) what is the address of its principal place of business (iv) what are the names and addresses of its directors and officers (v) and what was the last rank in Her Majesty's service (if any) held by each of the above persons (c) if the organization is a partnership or a sole proprietorship, what are the names and addresses and last rank in Her Majesty's service (if any) held by each of the partners or the sole proprietor, as the case may be?

3. Has an agreement been entered into between Her Majesty the Queen and the organization for the provision of canteen facilities to ranks of the Canadian Army below the rank of sergeant and, if so (a) what was the date of such agreement (b) how long does it continue in force (c) is there any provision for its early termination by Her Majesty the Queen and (d) is any right reserved to Her Majesty to control the prices charged at such canteens?

4. Are the Sergeants' and/or Officers' Messes at any or all of the Canadian Army locations at which the organization operates, required to purchase their supplies from the organization, and is the current price for beer, soft drinks, coffee and doughnuts at the establishment of the organization at Camp Gagetown in excess of the current price for such articles at the Officers' and/or Sergeants' Messes at such camp and, if so, why?
