I would be, as far as I am concerned, very much interested in the establishment at McGill of a Chair of Italian Literature, indeed I have already proposed this several times to the Faculty of Arts; but since last year the department of which I am chairman has changed its title and is now called the Department of French Language and Literature. This means that if a professor of Italian were appointed at McGill a new department would have to be formed called the Department of Italian Language and Literature. I am therefore transmitting your letter to Mr. Morgan, Frincipal of McGill, and to the Dean of the Faculty of Arts.

I hope that your proposal will be ultimately accepted and I promise you that I shall vote enthusiastically for it.
