## A LETTER

# Mr. J. WALIG,

## To Meffrs. Nic. and Jacob Van Staphorst.

### Helder, Jan. 3, 1775.

"In an fiver to your letter of the 22d of December, concerning the queftion, whether we have been nearer to the "Pole than 80 deg. and a half, I muft inform you, that we have "been often to 81 deg. near the Seven Iflands, to the North-"ward of the North-Eaft land, and fome have been in 82 deg. "but then not clear from ice, in which they drove about. I never heard of any difcoveries made there, as they have always been fifthers, who driving with the ice, to the Northward, leave that direction upon getting room; and when now and then the fea has been free from ice, that has happened commonly in the months of June and July. In 1763. I fpoke with a Scotch Captain in Greenland, who told me he had O 3 "been
