

Questions ordered to be divided, 124 — Question consisting of several paragraphs, considered paragraph by paragraph in their order, page 49 — Question put by Speaker when Debate is ended, 125 — If Question not heard, Speaker will state it again, 125 — Question determined by the majority of voices, 126 — Speaker states whether "Ayes" or "Noes" have it; but if this not acquiesced in, a division ensues, 127 — The same Question may not be proposed twice in the same Session, 128.

*QUORUM—House and Committee of the Whole House* — At three o'clock House counted, when, if Twenty Members present, Speaker takes the Chair, 50 — If Twenty not present, Speaker adjourns House till next sitting day, 51 — When Twenty Members not present at an earlier sitting, no business entered upon until they are; but no adjournment until three o'clock, 52 — When the Usher of the Black Rod is announced, Speaker takes the Chair, even if there be no quorum, page 25 — A Summons from the Lieutenant Governor makes a House, 53 — When Twenty found not to be present during a sitting after three o'clock, Speaker adjourns House till next sitting day, 54 — When
