M. S. Schell and Dr. McKay Are Chosen as Next Candidates.
 TILLSONBURG, May 28.—In convention to-day, South Oxford Liberals nominated M. S. Schell, M.P., to contest the riding at the next Dominion election, and Dr. McKay of Ingersoll for the next provincial election. The meeting was very largely attended.

COVINGTON, Ky., May 28.—Judge W. G. Loving was to-day indicted for the murder of Theodore Iests, whom he charged with wronging his daughter. Judge Loving pleaded not guilty and was bailed in \$7000, the surety being Judge John D. Horsley of Lynchburg.

Barge Ashore at Southampton.
 SOUTHAMPTON, Ont., May 28.—During last night's heavy gale, the tug barge Dolly Morden and a scow, both loaded with lumber, broke away from the dock and are now on the beach inside the harbor. They are on a sand bottom and not likely damaged, and can be floated easily after lightning cargo.
