THE MIKADO AND REGINA.

Returns From Lake-of-the-Woods Ore.

A London Publication Gives Figures Regarding the Closs-Engish Corporations Operating Near Rat Portage - Deer Park Shipments-Mining Stocks.

Up to date Canadians have remained to a great extent in doubt as to the real worth of the gold mines in the Lake of the Woods.

The public has always been kept in ignorance as regards the actual output of the three gold-producing properties in that region—the Mikado, the Regina, and the Regia.

A little light, however, is thrown upon the output of these two properties by some figures appearing in Mathieson's Monthly Mining Handbook, published at 16 Coltham-avenue, London, E.

MANY FLOATING BODIES.

La Bourgoigne Victims in Considerable Numbers Seen by Passengers on the Westernland.

New York, Aug. 2.—The steamship Westernland arrived in this port yesterday and on board report that when 60 miles south of Sable Island and within about one mile of the spot where La Bourgoigne went down, last month ago, the bodies of 20 men and 2 women were seen floating in the water.

The steamship Hiawatha, sent out from Halifax to recover and identify the dead of La Bourgoigne, was sighted by the Westernland in the neighborhood of this human wreckage, and was engaged in the work for which it was sent out.


