



# Indian Land Sale.

Lots numbers 6, 7, 8, 9, & the South half of 10 in the 8<sup>th</sup> Concession of the said Township, Containing in all nearly 2700 Acres.

These lands are situated in the heart of a fine Agricultural District, about twelve miles distant from the Town of Windsor, and six from Amherstburg, and are not excelled in quality by any lands in the Country.

They will be offered for Sale in separate 100 acre lots, a few of which are obliquely intersected by the Canada Southern Railway, and are subject to deduction in quantity on that account.
