O'DONOVAN ROSSA DEAD

New York, June 29.—Jeremiah O'Don-
ovan, better known as O'Donovan
Rossa, Irish patriot and revolution-
ist, died in St. Vincent's Hospital, Staten
Island tonight. He had been ill for many
months.He spent the last half of his life in
the United States, twenty years of which
were passed under an edict of banish-
ment from Great Britain and any of her
possessions. He was granted a full par-
don by Queen Victoria in 1881
