

ROBBERIES IN CHICAGO

New York, June 26—A request from Chicago to arrest Edward A. Aaron for postal thefts in Chicago furnished the police with a possible explanation of many mail box robberies on Washington Heights which have puzzled them for more than a month. Aaron was found living at 567 West 191st street, and in his pockets were money orders and checks which, the police say, he admitted taking from boxes in apartment houses.

A will was found on Aaron, according to the police, which is believed to have been extracted from a letter box. It was the will of Jacob Baehr of 501 West 187th street and had been carried about for some time. Whether it had been mailed to a lawyer for probate was not learned. Aaron said he was an automobile salesman, and had been in New York since May 9. He had operated for a time in Cleveland and Detroit after leaving Chicago and before coming to this city.

Aaron was held by Magistrate Oberwager in \$10,000 bail on a charge of grand larceny.

KEEPS BAN ON

GOLD EXPORT Ottawa, June 26—(Canadian Press)—A proclamation has been issued extending the prohibition of the export of gold coin, gold bullion and fine gold bars for another year. This is issued under an act passed three years ago authorizing the continuance of the measure taken during the war to prohibit the export of gold. The present extension of the prohibition will keep it in force until July 1, 1928, unless an earlier termination is made by proclamation.


