





The annual report of the Executive was as follows:

The Executive of the Saint John Association for the Prevention of Tuberculosis begs to present its annual report of work done from November 1, 1919, to November 1, 1920.

The Dispensary at No. 74 Carmarthen street, has been open 166 days during the year, 108 days for adults and 58 days for children, that is, Monday at 2,30 p. m., and Thursday evening at 7 p. m. for adults, and Friday at 2,30 p. m. for adults, and Friday at 2,30 p. m. for adults, and Friday at 2,30 p. m. for children.
