## TEXTILE PRODUCTS ABOVE \$80,000,000

Industry Had a Good Year in  
1919—Quebec Leads in  
Production.

The Canadian textile industry had a very good year during 1919. Official figures show that there were 27 plants in operation of which 12 were in Quebec, 11 in Ontario, 3 in New Brunswick and 1 in Nova Scotia. Quebec is the centre of the industry. Of the \$88,722,941 invested in it, \$87,462,211 is to be found in that province. Ontario comes second with \$18,932,846. Nova Scotia \$4,536,287. New Brunswick, \$2,201,178. The distribution of capital is as follows: Looms, buildings and fixtures, \$14,016,073; machinery and tools, \$21,209,919; materials, stocks in process, finished product, and miscellaneous, \$12,022,191; cash, trading and other accounts, \$11,499,556. The number of persons employed is given as 16,124, the wages and salaries paid during the year being \$124,081,091. Of the employees, 7,405 are female and 8,719 male. The cost at the mill of the material used during the year was \$48,616,617. The value of the year's product at the mills was \$82,642,948.

The growing importance of the industry is to be seen in the increase of the exports of cotton goods during the last seven years, the returns being for fiscal periods, in 1913 their value was \$124,651; 1914, \$130,196; 1915, \$206,907; 1916, \$181,846; 1917, \$21,461,116; 1918, \$2,020,095; 1919, \$3,492,205; 1920 \$6,146,697.

For the five months ending August, 1920, the exports were valued at \$1,807,431, an advance of \$800,000 over those for the same months in the preceding year.

## U. S. MONEY GETS STALLION BRAGE

Halifax Has Word of Terms  
Accepted

National Control of Ring in  
United States Proposed—  
The Six-Day Grind—Base-  
ball and Other Late Sport.

Toronto, Ont., Dec. 7.—Frank Fredericks, captain of the world's champion Falcons of Winnipeg, was in Toronto last night and was among the skaters at the arena. He has completed his course at Camp Borden and expects to leave for the west tonight. He said he had received offers from Frank Patrick and E. J. Livingston and had declined both.

Halifax, N. S., Dec. 7.—Word was received today by R. H. Edwards, owner of the trotting stallion Brage, 2111/2, from Lyman Brase, a Grand Circuit driver, and trainer for Brock Farm, Chester, N. Y., accepting his terms for the purchase of that known horse.

The price is said to be a good one. Brage, like Bill Sharon, recently sold for \$35,000, was bred in maritime provinces, being sired by Baring 212/4, dam Jessie Rampart by Rampart, both owned by E. H. Edwards. He was foaled in Halifax in 1912 and was developed, trained and driven by Frank Boutlier. He was the maritime province champion two year old in 1914; he lowered the three-year-old trotting record to 2:20 1/4 in 1915; and the four-year-old trotting record to 2:15 1/4 in 1916. Two years later he trotted in 2:16 1/4.

Akron, Ohio, Dec. 7.—Benny Frush, of Baltimore and Aris Ross, of Cleveland will meet in a 12-round bout here tonight.

Chicago, Dec. 7.—Billard enthusiasts following the national billiard tournament here today were told that Edouard Hoernemann, Belgian billiard champion, will be in Chicago on Saturday and part of next week, as a spectator of the finals. It is said he will challenge the new national champion, whose name has not yet been announced.

Portland, Ore., Dec. 7.—Walter H. McCredie, manager of the Portland baseball team, today announced that negotiations are under way for the purchase of George Maisel, Portland outfielder by the New York Giants. He said Maisel himself is conducting the negotiations.

Chicago, Dec. 7.—Chicago baseball fans will welcome Johnny Evers, former second baseman and now manager of the Cubs, back to the fold with a banquet and home-coming party here tonight. Reservations indicate that close to 1,000 will attend. Much gratification was expressed by Evers over the receipt of the signed contract of Grover Cleveland Alexander, manager of the pitching staff, and word from Fletcher Jim Vaughn that he is in shape and expects to sign his new contract soon.
