MARINE NOTES.

The steamer Eskasoni, 1682, sailed on Cuba direct for this port on February 18. She has about 4,000 tons of raw sugar for the Atlantic Sugar Refinery and is expected to arrive about February 28. The consignees are J. T. Night & Co.

Vroom & Arnold have received a report that the schooner Passaguid, Captain T. Dismore, has lost her rudder and anchor and went ashore off Michaels Me. She is being towed in to that port for repairs.

Nagle & Wigmore expect the Bilbster Franchida Line, to arrive on Tuesday. She is coming from La Havre direct. The Sturnia, Anchor-Donaldson Line, Robert Reford Co., agents, has been reported by wireless and was expected to arrive at Halifax yesterday from Glasgow. She will disembark passengers and discharge part cargo and then proceed to Portland.

The Eastern Steamship Company announced yesterday that the service between Boston and St. John would in all probability be resumed on April 1. The Calvin Austin, which is being converted into an oil burner, will in all probability be placed on the route.

HOUDINI REGISTERS SURE THIS TIME!

A Thriller of Thrillers at the Imperial—Miraculous Aeroplane Stunts.

Thrills and mystery that keep one's eyebrows and gusses constantly alarmed permeate a film story entitled "The Grim Game," that, with the agile Houdini in the leading role, opened as the attraction at the Imperial Theatre yesterday.

Digest's "Fables of the Day." The Rotary Club entertained things greatly with their songs and cheers and a genuine night of fun was had by all hands.

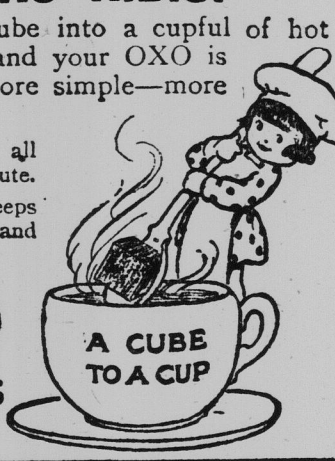

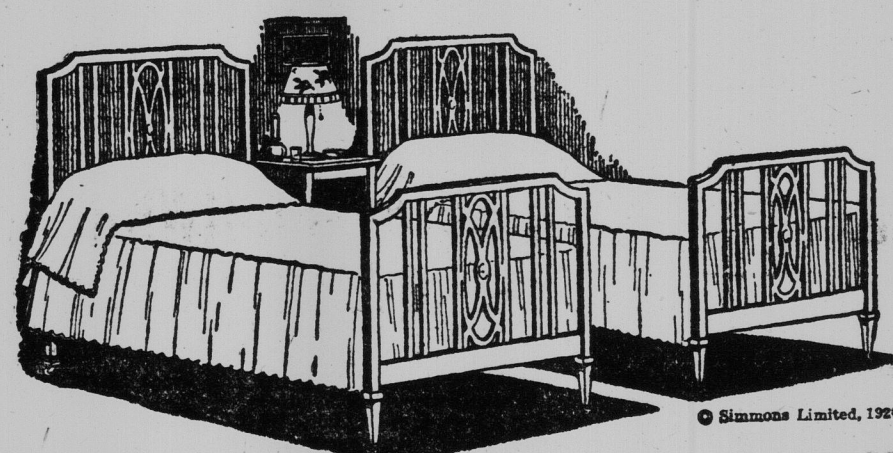
