2. CIVIL OCCUPATION - Engagement in by Officers & Other Ranks.

1. CARO 2479 is hereby cancelled.
2. The u/m personnel, while serving with the Armed Forces are, except as provided in Para 3 below, forbidden except on the auth. of NDHQ to engage directly or indirectly in any civil occupation either full time or part time.
 - (a) Officers and other ranks of Active Units and Formations of the CA.
 - (b) Officers and O/Rs placed on active service or called out for any military purpose pursuant to the provisions of Sec 63 or 64 of the Militia Act.
 - (c) Personnel called up under NEMA.
3. Provisions of CARO 3112 will not be construed to prohibit members of the forces from engaging in work in fish processing plants during hours which they may be permitted to be outside the camp area and not on military duty.
4. This Order will not apply to personnel who:
 - (a) Are given leave of absence without pay & Allowances for the express purpose of returning to industry or other civil occupation.
 - (b) Are employed in emergencies under the prov. of Para 2 of CARO 3112. (Auth: CARO 3112, 1943)
