Sir,-

I beg to advise you that Mrs. Boyce reports to me that during the last quarter she has received from the New England Company \$1282.00 and from the Department \$1000.00 and has an over draft at the bank of \$278.48.

Up to date she had accounts rendered amounting to \$3100.00 which does not include the bills of the butcher, the boot and shoe merchants or the merchant. She estimates that it will require \$5000.00 to pay for these accounts, salaries and any other items and leave her out of debt by the 1st. of November. These figures do not include coal. I beg to ask for instructions in regard to this.
